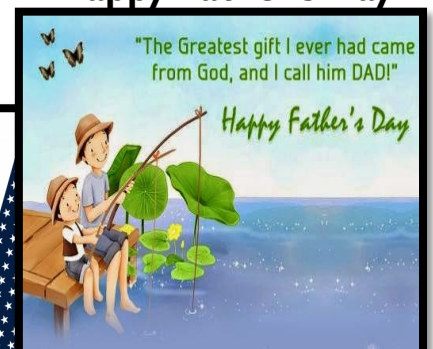


Office Closure
